Presented by Art Historian, Katherine Zoraster

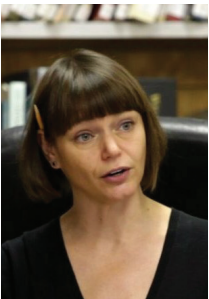
